

Product Update: Release Simbus SR2022.0.1.1

We will be releasing SR2022.0.1.1 of our products (currently, the combination of the Simbus Core Toolbox $^{\text{TM}}$ and Simbus Bondgraphs $^{\text{TM}}$) on 31 October, 2022. All current users will be notified to update their installation. This includes users who have annual licenses, trial licenses, or run-time licenses. SR2022.0.1.1 is a maintenance release but it includes the ability to save models irrespective of the license type (so run-time license owners can save models) and also when your license has expired.
